

TILE CLEANER

Acid detergent for tiles.

APPLICATION RANGE

Cleaning of cement, lime, adhesive and cement grout residues on ceramic tiles and mosaics, on porcelain surfaces such as basins and bathtubs, on chrome- plated metal surfaces, stainless steel and anodised aluminium. Removal of efflorescence from ceramic tiles, grouts, concrete and plasters. If it is applied correctly, it does not damage the joints, even coloured ones, filled with Tile Grout <8 mm and Tile Grout 2-15 mm.

FEATURES

Tile Cleaner is a watery solution of a strong organic acid which has a special dissolving action for cement, lime and efflorescence.

AVVERTENZE

- Tile Cleaner causes severe skin burns and serious eye injuries. Avoid contact with the skin.
- Protect from frost.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Scrape away the dirt (using a spatula or steel brush, for example). If required, protect the surrounding areas from splashes of acid.

Wet absorbent surfaces such as terracotta, concrete and plasters. Wear gloves, boots and goggles. Apply the detergent in strips with a scrubbing brush and let it take effect for approx. 5 minutes. Clean the liquid acid from the floor with a sponge and then rinse with water and wipe the surface well. Dry with a cloth. If required, repeat the entire operation.

CONSUMPTION

The consumption of Tile Cleaner depends on the substrate, the degree of dirt and the necessary cleaning.

STORAGE

Store Tile Cleaner in a fresh and sheltered place. In the original closed packaging it is kept for at least 36 months. PROTECT FROM FROST.
